- Authorised and worked as an Instructed Person under the Power System Safety Rules or industry equivalent on at least three (3) separate locations separated by time and environment in the last twelve (12) months or over a minimum period of at least four (4) weeks

- Identify Safe Approach Distances applicable to live electrical apparatus
- Demonstrate an understanding of the requirements for Personnel Protective Equipment
- Demonstrate an understanding of the risks of electromagnetic and electrostatic induction to personnel
- Demonstrate an understanding of the Principles of Isolation
- Demonstrate an understanding of the Principles of Earthing
- Demonstrate an understanding of hazard identification
